Date: Write the current date. This helps you keep track of your progress and reflections over time.

Scripture: Write down the Bible passage you're studying. This could be a single verse or a larger passage.


Observation: Write down what you notice in the Scripture passage. What stands out? What did you learn about God? About people? About living the Christian life?

Application: Write down how you can apply the Scripture passage to your own life. What is God saying to you? How can you live out what you've learned?

Prayer: Write down your response to God. This could be a prayer of thanks, a confession of sin, a request for help, or anything else that's on your heart.

I've also included a second page to record any messages or impressions that you get while your studying.

Remember, this is your personal conversation with God. There's no right or wrong way to do it. The goal is to grow in your relationship with Him through His Word. Happy studying!
